

## **Executive Member Research Terms and Conditions (telephone interviews)**

### **Entry**

1. Manchester United Limited (“**MU**”) is the promoter of the Executive Member Research competition (“**Competition**”).
2. All entrants to the Competition must be 18 years of age or over and eligible to travel.
3. Employees of MU (and the employees’ families) or any of its associated companies or subsidiaries are not eligible to enter the Competition.
4. Entry to the Competition is on the basis of one entry per person and entry shall be automatic when the entrant agrees to, and subsequently participates in, a telephone interview conducted by BDRC Group Limited (on behalf of MU) for the purposes of executive membership research.
5. By entering the Competition the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions (“**Conditions**”) and confirms that all information submitted is true, current and complete. MU reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants and may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any entrant that fails to satisfy eligibility requirements.

### **Prize**

6. The winner will be the first name to be selected at random from all of the eligible entries received pursuant to telephone interviews conducted on or before 24 December 2009.
7. Only the winner shall receive notification from MU. The winner will be notified by telephone as soon as is practicable after the end of the executive membership research and by no later than 31 December 2009.
8. If MU cannot successfully contact the winner within a reasonable length of time (using the contact details it holds) it may, in its sole discretion, select another winner at random.
9. The decision of MU is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. The prize for the Competition is a travel package for two people, to include flights, accommodation and match tickets, to a Manchester United European away game (“**Prize**”). In particular:
  - (i) The Prize shall be available for use at a European away match (to be reasonably agreed between the parties) during either season 2009/10 or 2010/11. This is at all times subject to availability and MU reserves the right to specify the match and/or football season in respect of the Prize if, in its sole discretion, it considers necessary.
  - (ii) MU’s official travel partner, Co-Operative Group Limited (“**Co-Op Travel**”), shall provide the Prize on behalf of MU. The flights and accommodation provided to the winner shall be of a quality similar to those usually supplied within standard European Co-Op Travel packages. Details of the flights and accommodation shall be confirmed to the winner at a later date, and are subject to availability.
11. Ancillary costs and expenses associated with the Prize, such as subsistence, will not be provided by MU and shall be borne by the winner.
12. The Prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. MU reserves the right to substitute the Prize with another of a similar nature and/or equal or greater value at any time.

### **General**

13. By entering the Competition, the winner consents to the following: (i) for the winner’s name to be disclosed to any person requesting that MU confirm the identity of the Competition winner; and (ii) for the winner’s name and/or photograph to be published for promotional or marketing purposes.
14. MU reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition or these Conditions without notice in the event of the occurrence of circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
15. MU will use any personal information submitted by the entrant in accordance Data Protection Legislation and the privacy preferences (if any) specified by the entrant during the telephone interview.
16. The Competition, together with these Conditions, is governed by the laws of England and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
