

Speed Goal Competition - Terms and Conditions

Entry

1. Manchester United Limited ("**MU**") is the promoter of the Speed Goal Competition (the "**Competition**").
2. Employees of MU (and the employees' families) or any of its associated companies or subsidiaries are not eligible to enter the Competition.
3. Entry to the Competition is on the basis of one entry per person and entry shall be automatic when the entrant completes the Speed Goal Competition form and hand's it to the member of staff manning the Speed Goal, during the entrant's visit to the Manchester United Museum.
4. By entering the Competition the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions (the "**Conditions**") and confirms that all information submitted is true, current and complete. MU reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants and may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any entrant that fails to satisfy eligibility requirements.

Prize

5. The Competition will be split into three categories, Under 10s, Under 16s and Open Age. The entries with the fastest shot time recorded in each category will be the Winners and each will win a Prize (each jointly and severally referred to as the "**Winners**").
6. Entries will be processed, and the Winners will be selected, every 6 weeks from 1 March 2010 (except during the closed season as there are no home games during this period. Draws will resume once the new season commences).
7. Only the Winners shall receive notification from MU. The Winners will be notified either by email, telephone and/or in writing as soon as is practicable after the Winners are selected.
8. If MU cannot successfully contact the Winners within a reasonable length of time it may, in its sole discretion, offer the Prize to the entrant with the next fastest shot time recorded in that particular age category.
9. The decision of MU is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10.
 - a) The Prize for winning the Competition is two tickets to a Manchester United home game (the "**Prize**")
 - b) The Prize will be given to the Winner in each category as set out in Clause 5.The choice of game is subject to availability and at the sole discretion of MU.
11. Ancillary costs and expenses associated with the Prize, such as travel and subsistence, will not be provided by MU and shall be borne by the Winners.
12. The Prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. MU reserves the right to substitute any Prize with another of a similar nature and/or equal or greater value at any time. If the Winner is unable or unwilling to accept the Prize, subsequent draws will take place until new Winners are found who are able/willing to accept the Prize.

General

13. By entering the Competition, the Winners (and their parent or guardian if the entrant is under 16 years of age) consent to the following: (i) for the Winners' names to be disclosed to any person requesting that MU confirm the identity of the Winners; and (ii) for the Winners' names and/or photographs to be published for promotional or marketing purposes.
14. MU reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition or these Conditions without notice in the event of the occurrence of circumstances beyond its reasonable control. MU also reserves the right to refuse entry to, or refuse to award a Prize to, anyone in breach of these rules.
15. MU will use any personal information submitted by the entrant in accordance Data Protection Legislation and the privacy preferences (if any) specified by the entrant on the Speed Goal Competition form.
16. The Competition, together with these Conditions, is governed by the laws of England and Wales and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
