

United Review Season Ticket Competition Terms and Conditions

Entry

1. Manchester United Limited and Manchester United Football Club Limited (“**MU**”) are the promoters of the prize draw (“**Competition**”).
2. Employees of MU and the Haymarket Network or any of their associated companies or subsidiaries (and the employees families) are not eligible to enter the Competition.
3. To enter the prize draw, participants must be have submitted their entries by midnight on Monday 17th May 2010.
4. By entering the Competition the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions (“**Conditions**”).
5. To be eligible for the prize, entrants must input 6 codes available in United Review (from 7 available in total) via manutd.com. Each code entered must be from a different fixture, and entrants must keep their original coded inserts as proof, to be submitted and checked if contacted, before final confirmation of winning.

Prize

6. The winners will be the first 2 names chosen at random from all eligible entries on Tuesday 18th May 2010.
7. Only the winners will receive notification by MU. The winner will be notified by telephone, email and/or post (depending on what contact information we hold or is provided on submission of the entry) as soon as practicable after the draw has been made.
8. If we cannot contact the winners within 48 hours of the closing date a winner being drawn (making reasonable efforts), then MU may, in its sole discretion, select another winner at random for that prize.
9. The decision of MU is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. There are two prizes of a Season Ticket for the 2010/11 season in a location and of a value to be decided by MU.
11. Travel, hospitality and any other associated costs are not included as part of the prize and the winner will be responsible for all additional costs incurred for the purchase of for all home cup matches and must provide card details which will be used by the club to make these purchases. If the winner refuses to pay such costs or provide card details then the prize will be forfeited.
12. Use of the Season Tickets will be subject to the Season Ticket Terms and Conditions 2010/11 which will be available on the MU website at the point at which the winner is announced.
13. The prizes are non-transferable, and no cash alternatives are available. If a winner is unable or unwilling to accept the prize, subsequent draws will take place until a new winner is found who is able/willing to accept the prize.
14. Manchester United reserves the right to refuse entry to, or refuse to award the prize to, anyone in breach of these Conditions.

General

15. By entering the Competition, the winner consents to the following: (i) for the winner’s name to be disclosed to any person requesting that MU confirm the identity of the Competition winner; and (ii) for the winner’s name and/or photograph to be published for promotional or marketing purposes.
16. MU reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition or these Conditions without notice in the event of the occurrence of circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

17. MU will use any personal information submitted by the entrant in accordance Data Protection Legislation and the privacy preferences (if any) specified by the entrant during submission of the entry.

18. The Competition, together with these Conditions, is governed by the laws of England and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
