

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#IAMUNITED FAN VIEWING PARTY

1. Manchester United Limited ("**MU**") is the promoter of the ticket ballot ("**Ballot**") for the #IAMUNITED Fan Viewing Party taking place on 16 March 2014 at The Aviator, Pudong District, Shanghai, China (the "**Event**").

2. Entry to the Ballot is on the basis of one entry per person and each entrant shall be entitled to apply for a maximum of four tickets for the Event. In order to enter, entrants must complete all required fields on the relevant entry form.

3. The closing date for entries to the Ballot is 00:00am midnight GMT on 7 March 2014 ("**Closing Date**"). All entries received after the Closing Date shall not be entered into the Ballot. The successful entrants will receive an email from MU early in the week beginning 10 March 2014.

4. By entering the Ballot the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions ("**Conditions**") and confirms that all information submitted is true, current and complete. MU reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants and may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any entrant that fails to satisfy the eligibility requirements.

5. Any individual entering the Ballot to obtain a ticket for a third party shall be deemed to be acting with the consent of each third party for whom they are making that entry, including acting with the authority of each such third party to agree to these Conditions on their behalf.

6. The Ballot is not open to employees of MU (or its associated companies or subsidiaries) or their families.

7. The successful entrants will receive up to four complimentary tickets to the Event. Successful entrants will be selected at random from all of the eligible entries received on or before the Closing Date. On allocation of the tickets, successful entrants will receive a PDF copy of the tickets along with further instructions and conditions of entry with which the entrant and any guests must comply.

8. Please note allocation of tickets in respect of the Event will not guarantee entry. In particular, the capacity of the Event venue is limited so individuals who receive tickets should ensure they arrive early for the Event to avoid disappointment. MU shall have no liability to any individual in possession of a ticket who does not gain entry to the Event when the capacity of the Event venue has been reached.

9. Anyone wishing to purchase alcoholic drinks at the Event may be required to produce valid photo-identification to prove that they are over 21 years of age.

10. Ancillary costs and expenses associated with attending the Event, such as subsistence, will not be provided by MU and shall be borne by the successful entrants.

11. All tickets are non-transferable and no cash alternative is available.

12. MU reserves the right to cancel or amend the Ballot or these Conditions without notice in the event of the occurrence of circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

13. The Ballot, together with these Conditions, is governed by the laws on England and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
